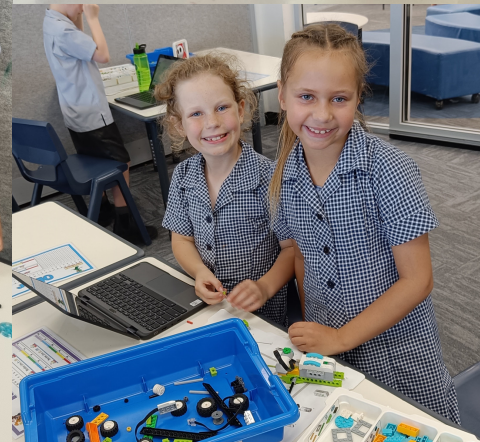

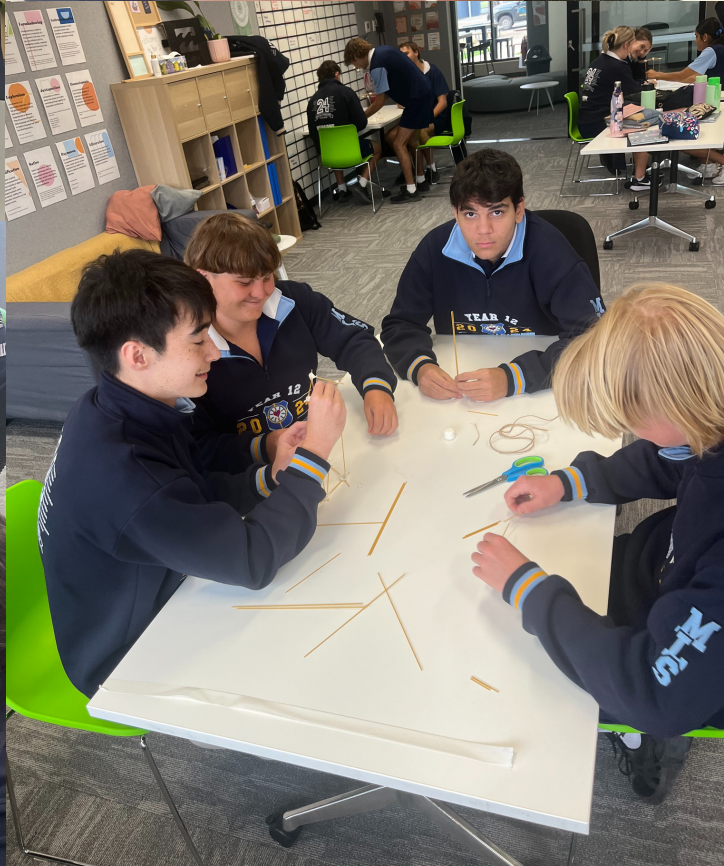
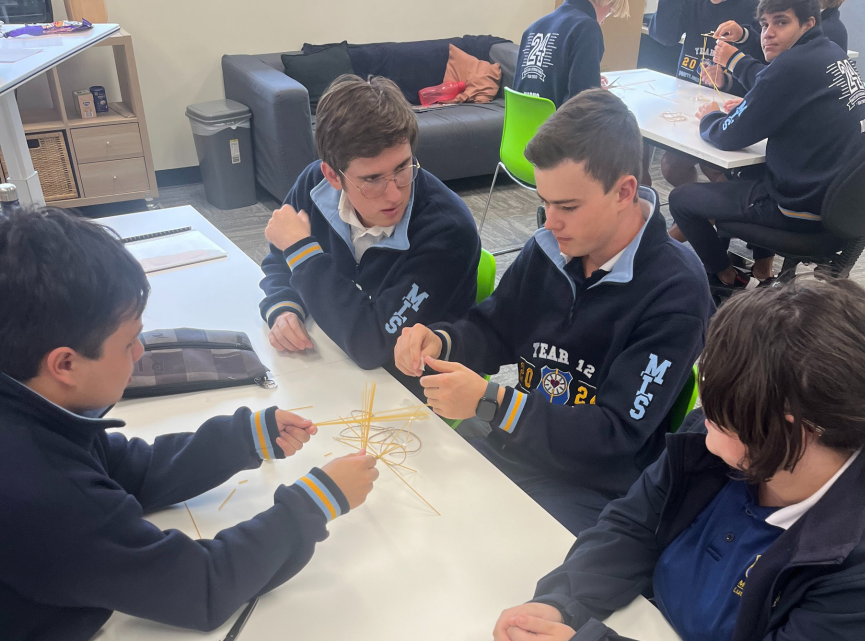
CLEAN UP AUSTRALIA DAY

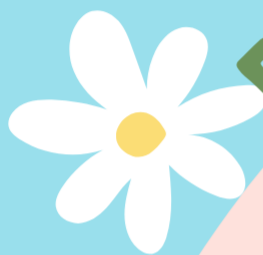

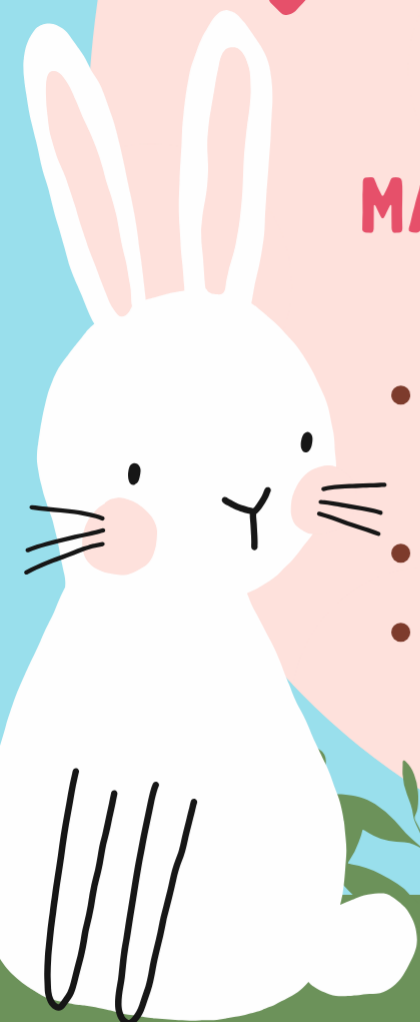
