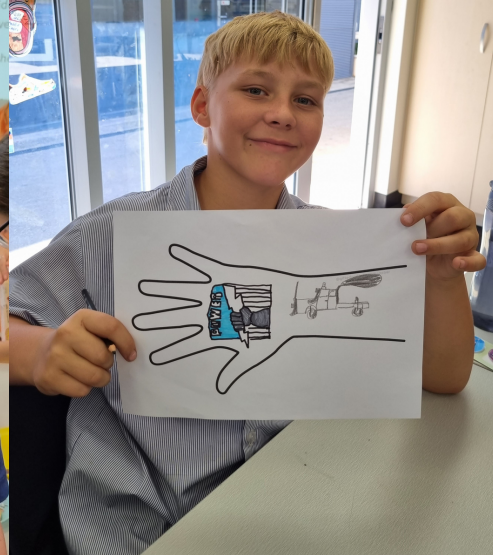

SCHOOL BUSES: SOME IMPROVEMENTS ARE IMMINENT

Our team has been working on some improvements to our school bus services.

So what sort of things have they been working on?

A new and improved school bus app! You may like to know that we will soon be rolling out an improved bus app. This will make it much easier for parents to track our buses and to know when their child is on board.

The roll-out will happen soon, and parents of bus-students will receive more details about it within the next few weeks.

They have been reviewing the bus routes to see if any can be simplified or shortened. We are conscious that some of our students are on the buses for quite a while each day. The students are tired by the time they get home. Our team has been reviewing each of the runs to see if any of the routes can be tweaked to enable students to get home, or to sport, any sooner. Whilst most of the runs are not earmarked for any changes, at least one of our routes is likely to see some tweaks. We are currently assessing the planned changes in an attempt to ensure that in benefiting some, they do not disadvantage others. Anyone whose children are on an impacted route will receive more details about it within the next few weeks.
